


Hank's Garage



Glimpse of Bugatti Veyron 16 cylinder 987 HP

It takes the Bugatti Veyron 16 cylinders, 8.0-liters, and 1,001 HP (987 HP/746 kW) to break the 250 mph (402 km/h) barrier but it only took the MG EX181 4 cylinders and 300 HP to do the same thing.

The 1.5-liter engine made just 68 hp (69 PS/51 kW) when it first nestled in the MGAs engine bay, but by the time MG added a massive supercharger to it, and pumped 32 pounds of boost into it, it could make 300 hp (304 PS/224 kW).

Indeed, as you may be able to intuit, this was a very slippery car. Thanks to the shape, which was achieved by making the rear track width narrower than the front, some claim that the car had a coefficient of drag of just 0.12.


