MOTOR OIL NOTES

You need to know where your next can of 20W50 oil is coming from. *Do you?*

Just when I thought I had found a perfect oil for my British cars, **WalMart** decided to no longer carry **Castrol GTX Classic 20W50.** And they had been the exclusive marketer for it. **Castrol** informed me **AutoZone** was now the exclusive seller.

So today I went to the **AutoZone** near me. Employees there could barely spell OIL. None was on display and if they had any behind the counter they didn't know about it. I didn't have an immediate need

so I came home and checked eBay. I now have a 5 qt jug on its way for only \$25.99 plus tax and with free shipping. Pretty sure it would have been significantly more from AutoZone. Finding a good high zinc oil is more difficult than necessary.

Additional note: 20 W 50 Oil

Most places that sell high zinc motor oil like VR1 don't have it out on display where customers could just pick it up. They might mistakenly use it in their modern cars. shorten the life of their catalytic converters, and then sue the store where they accidentally bought it. WalMart's lawyers probably were worried that their customers were just dumb enough to do that. Plus it likely wasn't just flying off their shelves with no advertising.

Maybe Moss will pick up the distribution contract. But then it would cost \$50 a jug plus shipping and handling.

I should probably stock up while eBay still has some.



Commentary on the Overdrive Lubrication

From Steve Olson

The guy that runs **Quantum Mechanics** where they rebuild many of our Overdrives says **gear oil is too thick** and can overpressurize components. **20 W 50** has additives that may foam up. He insists straight **30 non-detergent is best.**

Detergent oils keep particles in suspension and keep them circulating. With no real filter to grab them we are better off letting them settle to the bottom. He also thinks tranny lube needs to be changed every couple years.

When I recently dropped the cover on my Overdrive, the screen and filter both had almost nothing trapped in them. The magnets had a coating of very fine metallic particles.

I did replace one O-ring on the pump piston that looked like it might have hardened. I have tried almost all lubricants except Extra Virgin Olive Oil and currently run **20 W 50**.

The **90-140 Gear Oil** did seem too thick to let the synchros work and the **ATF** seemed too thin to not leak out. **Red Line** and other "special" lubes are too pricey for me.

......In the future I might try some straight 30 lawnmower oil.

MG Mitten and the art of selling accessories - by David LaChance

If there was anything that postwar American driving enthusiasts loved as much as their little British roadsters, it was dressing them up. Overnight, an entire cottage industry arose, catering to owners' needs to bedeck their sports cars with driving lamps, bumper overriders, sheepskin seat covers, and any number of other items to make them even more fun to live with—and to make them stand out in gatherings with fellow enthusiasts. Many of these sellers also offered all the gear needed to go racing, which back then wasn't much more than a helmet and some seatbelts.

MG Mitten was one of the pioneers in the field, and one of the most enduring, too, mailing out catalogs and parts from its Pasadena, California, warehouse from the early 1950s to the mid1980s. Running the ship was founder Marion Weber, who greeted her customers with a breezy little commentary each month in the ads she ran in *Road & Track* and *Sports Cars Illustrated*, later *Car and Driver*.

The "Mitten" part of MG Mitten was a car cover, offered in a variety of fabrics for a range of sports cars. The cover was Weber's first product, launched in 1952 after a car cover she'd made for her husband's MG TC left his car club buddies clamoring for copies. The Mitten was followed by Healey Huggers, Porsche Parkas, Fiat Frocks, Jaguar Jackets, and other tailored covers with similarly alliterative names, all manufactured by a company called Covercraft International. She added to the catalog a variety of gear from other suppliers, items like wooden shift knobs, driving gloves, sports jackets, steering wheel covers, SU adjusting tools, and much more.
